

NCYC CODE OF CONDUCT AND RELEASE AND WAIVER

I/we give my/our child permission to participate in The National Catholic Youth Choir at St. John's University. I/we hereby release The National Catholic Youth Choir (NCYC this point forward), Collegetville, MN, and all of its employees, agents, and officers from all liability for any injury or claim I/we may have arising out of my/our child's participation in NCYC. I/We certify that the nature of NCYC my/our child will participate in was explained to me/us and that I/we have read this release and understand all of its terms. I/we execute voluntarily and with full knowledge of its significance.

I also give my permission to have adult volunteer drivers transport my child to and from an airport as needed.

It is our goal to provide during the entire choir camp a Christian environment of discipline, self-control, charity, and respect for others. We hope that the following code of conduct provides a safe, happy, and respectful environment for participants, staff, and the St. John's University community. Please read through the following points carefully before signing this form. Any infraction of these rules may result in the student's parent(s)/guardian(s) being notified to bring their daughter/son home immediately. Completion of this agreement is mandatory for participation in The National Catholic Youth Choir.

1. I agree to abide by all rules established by the Director and to cooperate with all staff members. This includes dress code, curfews, cell phone use and quiet times.
2. I agree to remain for the entire camp and follow the camp schedule, programs, and activities unless prevented by reasons beyond my control.
3. I understand that camp authorities reserve the right to expel students for violation of rules and that under such circumstances no refunds will be made.
4. I understand that St. John's University and The National Catholic Youth Choir will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
5. I understand that I am responsible for the cost and arrangement of my transportation to St. John's University or to the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport the first day of camp and from St. John's University or the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport on the last day of camp.
6. I agree to not use or possess alcoholic beverages and/or any other illegal drug or substance including tobacco.
7. I agree not to use or possess any type of weapon or instrument that could be used as a weapon.
8. I agree not to tamper with smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, fire alarms or any other emergency equipment. The tampering of such items is considered a misdemeanor and is punishable by law.
9. I understand that I am not allowed to be in the dorm rooms or on the dorm floors of persons of the opposite sex at any time. I understand that inappropriate sexual contact or expression is not allowed. Harassment in any form will not be tolerated.
10. **I understand that I and my parent(s)/guardian(s) are responsible for the camp fee and that it is to be paid in full by the date listed on the student form.**

Cell Phones – Students are free to bring cell phones with them to St. John's. They are especially useful for those traveling by air. Once students are on campus cell phones will be checked in with their floor camp leader and then can be checked out from the camp leader in accord with the camp schedule.
