ROOMS - Each dorm room has the following: two single beds, two desks, towels, bedding, closets, and a sink with a medicine cabinet. There are two bathrooms with showers on each floor of the dorms. Gentlemen and ladies will stay in the same building but on separate floors. Camp leaders will be dispersed by gender throughout the floors.

*Room keys are checked out by each chorister upon arrival at Saint John's. At the end of NCYC room keys must be returned to camp leaders or to the Saint John's registration area. **If you lose your key, a key penalty of \$25 will be assessed to you.***

CELL PHONES - Students are free to bring cell phones with them to Saint John's. They are especially useful for those traveling by air. Once students are on campus cell phones will be checked in with their floor counselors. They can be checked out from the counselor in accord with the camp schedule.

MONEY - There is an ATM machine on campus and the Student Accounts Office will cash checks.

BOOKSTORE - The campus bookstore is open Monday - Friday from 8:30am - 4:30pm and 11:00am - 4:30pm Saturday - Sunday. Books, magazines, snacks, soda, toiletries, laundry soap, souvenirs, t-shirts, sweatshirts, shorts, caps, postcards, and posters are sold here.

VENDING MACHINES - Vending machines offering snacks, candy and soft drinks are located in the lounges or halls of each dorm.

INTERNET ACCESS - Students will not have access to the internet.

JOHNNIE BREAD - Johnnie bread is popular nation-wide. The dining service also packages a dry mix designed especially for bread makers. Our bread is available to purchase at the Great Hall Information Desk or you can call to have it sent to you.
